

- **3.** Make sure you **tick the items on the Contents List opposite**, as well as whether it is a Family or Unisex Elderly Shoebox.

PLEASE REMEMBER NOT TO PUT IN ANY FOOD (INC. BISCUITS), MEDICINES, BOOKS, TEA/COFFEE OR OUT OF DATE ITEMS, NO SANITARY ITEMS OR UNDERWEAR AS WE HAVE TO FOLLOW STRICT CUSTOMS REGULATIONS.
